23RD ANNUAL BLIZZARD RETREAT JANUARY 27-30

Join us Thursday, January 27, through Sunday, January 30, 2022, for the 23rd Annual Blizzard Writers Poetry Retreat across Park Street from Lake Pepin in Lake City.

We will not be wearing masks during the retreat, so you will be required to demonstrate that you are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and received your booster shot before Wednesday, January 12. In addition, you must have a negative COVID test a day or two (no more than three) before the retreat.

You must be a current (2022) LOMP member to attend. The fee for the Retreat is \$120 for the full weekend, from check-in at 4:00pm Thursday until 10:00am Sunday. If you do not need lodging, join us for \$20 per day (\$50 for the full weekend). Make checks payable to LOMP and mail to Retreat Coordinator Sue Chambers, PO Box 422, Mankato, MN 56002, by Friday, January 21. Bring food and/or beverages to share. If you have special needs or food allergies, bring what you need for the weekend. Participants will be grouped into meal preparation teams, and everyone will help clean up.

Bring poems to share at read-arounds, and prepare a poetry program that is at least 30 minutes in length. The program can be anything—physical activity that will stimulate writing; a writing workshop; a favorite author; a new form; a lecture; a special taped program that you want to lead a discussion on...the possibilities are endless. Joint programs are also permissible.
